Location

The conference will be held in the FH/University of Applied Sciences, St. Pölten (A-3100 St. Pölten, Matthias-Corvinus-Straße 15). Come in via main entrance.

Arrival

By plane and train ⇒ Every 30 minutes, the ÖBB Rail jet departs from the basement of Vienna International Airport to St. Pölten main station (duration: 55 minutes; ticket price: € 15,90; to get the ticket: https://tickets.oebb.at/en/ticket)

<u>By train</u> \Rightarrow Every 15 to 30 minutes a train departs from Vienna main station to St. Pölten main station (duration 30 minutes; € 14,40)

By bus ⇒ At St. Pölten main station take the exit 'Busterminal' (Bus lines 1 or 5 from/to stop 'Krankenpflegeschule', Bus line 3 from/to stop 'A. Sedlaczek-Gasse' or Bus line 7 from/to stop 'Matthias Corvinus-Straße'

By car \Rightarrow You can park for a fee in the parking garage (A-3100 St. Pölten, Mühlweg 36)

On foot ⇒ At St. Pölten main station, choose station the exit 'Mühlweg' (see overview on the right or video - https://youtu.be/ugfNpz88bD0)
